July 26, 2018, Chicago, IL--- Jewish Child & Family Services (JCFS) is pleased to announce Rabbi David Rosenberg, JCFS's Coordinator of Jewish Education, as the new co-chair of Jewish Women International's (JWI) Clergy Task Force to End Domestic Abuse in the Jewish Community.

The Task Force speaks publicly, develops and disseminates resources and training, and provides guidance to clergy working with families experiencing abuse. This group has members from countries around the world, including the United States, Israel, Canada and Australia, and is comprised of clergy from every Jewish denomination, some of whom are survivors of domestic abuse.
