

Applications for **HIAS Chicago** college scholarships will be available to download from **November 6th, 2017** until the submission date of **January 21st, 2018**.

All applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- An individual who immigrated to the United States with the assistance of HIAS Chicago;
 OR
- A U.S.-born child or grandchild of an individual who immigrated to the U.S. with the assistance of HIAS Chicago; OR
- Someone who applied for Permanent Residency (a "Green Card") or citizenship with the assistance of HIAS Chicago.

In addition, applicants must:

- Be Jewish
- Have lived in the United States for a minimum of 2 years.
- Demonstrate academic excellence, financial need, community service to the Jewish and broader communities, and a well-thought out educational plan.
- Begin or continue your education on a full-time basis in a 4-year college or university in the 2018-2019 academic year.
