

Refugee Resettlement Program Driver Volunteer Description

Purpose and description: Drivers help our refugee participants travel from their homes to medical, social security and other appointments as needed.

Responsibilities:

- Participants must be picked up at home (typically in the far north part of Chicago) and returned to home.
- Volunteers may be asked to help with some light activities in connection to the appointment, if possible for example, double check with client that they have insurance card and photo ID card, help participants check in upon arrival, etc.
- Volunteers are welcome to stay on site during the appointment or can travel off site and return at the time of pick up.
- Families who require car seats will have those with them for transport.

Location and Time Commitment:

- Appointments are typically in the north side of Chicago and will be during the day.
- We are looking for a minimum of six transports to appointments per year that coordinate with your schedule.
- The amount of time involved will vary depending on the appointment type and location.

Traits:

• Comfortable working with individuals of diverse faiths and backgrounds.

Eligibility:

• Volunteers are required to submit a volunteer application, provide a copy of driver's license and proof of vehicle insurance, clear a series of background checks, get fingerprints taken, get a tuberculosis test and provide proof of an initial COVID vaccine and at least one booster, and be at least 18 years of age.
