In April 2010, Michael was on the way to work when a truck crossed into his lane and changed his life

forever. After the accident, Michael was living in chronic pain. He also lost both of his beloved parents during that time. Michael suffered from severe depression along with an addiction to painkillers, culminating in a suicide attempt. He was left completely empty and in search of a new way to live.
