IN AN EMERGENCY OR CRISIS

Call 911 if you believe there is imminent risk of suicide or harm to others

- o Make sure to say that someone is experiencing a mental health crisis
- o Describe the nature of the emergency and whether or not there is a weapon present
- Share your relationship to the person experiencing the crisis
- o Ask for a Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) these are police or other emergency personnel who are trained to assist people with mental health problems
- 988Suicide and Crisis Lifeline. You can call or text 988 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. This is for individual and families struggling with both suicide issues and other mental health concern. More information is available here.
