IN AN EMERGENCY OR CRISIS

- Call 911 if you believe there is imminent risk of suicide or harm to others
 - o Make sure to say that someone is experiencing a mental health crisis
 - o Describe the nature of the emergency and whether or not there is a weapon present
 - Share your relationship to the person experiencing the crisis
 - Ask for a Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) these are police or other emergency personnel who are trained to assist people with mental health problems

Call or text if you are thinking about suicide, are worried about a friend or loved one, or would like emotional support.
