[Beit T'Shuvah](#) is a residential addiction treatment center based in the Los Angeles area and serving individuals from all regions that saves lives through a comprehensive program of Jewish spirituality, psychotherapy, and the 12-Steps.

[Communities Confronting Substance Use & Addiction \(CCSA\)](#) at Ohel in New York aims to eliminate the stigma around substance use and addiction in the Jewish community. CCSA offers online facilitated support groups for those impacted by a loved one's addiction. Online groups are available in the US and Israel.

[Our Jewish Recovery \(OJR\)](#) is an online community supporting Jews in recovery from any and all addictions and their loved ones. Multiple online peer support groups are offered as well as annual online retreats and special events.

[14Y Selah](#) is a NYC-based "participation-celebrated, perfection-averse, everyone-welcome community of people in recovery and recovery-curious, grounded in Jewish tradition. Selah has several online groups open to Jews in recovery from any location.

[Recovery From Addiction Birthright Israel Trips](#) The Recovery trip aims to reconnect young people in recovery or impacted by an addiction with their Jewish heritage and reclaim their role as active members in the Jewish community. In addition to all the traditional highlights and sightseeing, participants will also meet Israelis from different fellowships.

[Tikvah Center for Jewish Recovery and Healing](#) is a non-profit Jewish addiction treatment center in the Greater Chicago area. Individuals from all regions are welcomed as clients. Evidence-based practices using Jewish integrated addiction counseling are offered in a Jewish environment that promotes lasting recovery. Intensive Outpatient and Partial Hospitalization services are offered, along with a variety of professionally facilitated recovery groups.
